Contact has been made with LOCALITY who can provide support an estimate that this would take 2 years with funding requirements of £7k 2025/2026 and £8k 2026/2027 (total £15k) funds ror Medway Council to support local Neighbourhood Plans has also been withdrawn (there are discussions to try and renew these grants).
 - **c) Medway Local Plan 2041 Regulation 19** consultation finishes 11th August at 23:59 (a response will be submitted by the Clerk), after which the responses will be assessed and the plan submitted to a Planning Inspector, depending on Inspector response, it would be planned to adopt the plan at the end

od 2026. Until adopted, the plan does carry significant weight in planning decisions. No specific housing policy applications in Allhallows – there is a Windfall/Small sites policy that is intended to permit sustainable developments of up to around 60 dwellings.
