6:55pm: The Last Post (played in the church grounds)

7.00pm: Beacons of Light (beacon lit in church grounds)

7:05pm: Church Bell rings out

7:10pm: Church Service (during this Service, the names will be read out

of the 11 fallen soldiers from Allhallows)
